SAILING CARGO VESSEL "ANEMOS" IS APPROACHING AMERICA.

HER PROGRAM.

The first sailing cargo ship of TOWT's fleet is about to complete her maiden transatlantic voyage. Her holds are filled with over 1,000 tonnes of French cargo.

After just 15 days of sailing at an average speed still just below 10 knots, Sailing Vessel (SV) "Anemos" is currently only a few hundreds nautical miles from New York.

Estimated Time of Arrival (ETA): Tuesday 3rd, September; 06:00 am

Objective achieved for TOWT: the maiden voyage crossing has mostly been completed under sail. A revolution in sustainable maritime transport.

Anemos, a highly technological vessel measuring 81 meter long and 13 meter high, is the first sistership in a fleet of 8 ships. It can transport over 1100 tons of cargo using wind power, reducing emissions by more than 90% compared to a conventional container ship.

First successful transatlantic crossing

Departing from France on August 16th, TOWT's first sailing cargo ship will arrive in New York in a few days with a crew of just 7 sailors and over 900 US pallets of 1.2-ton cargo. The ship's route took into account the winds encountered, mainly from the west, forcing the ship to adjust its course to avoid the strongest winds.

The crew took their bearings in the first days of the crossing to adapt to the handling of a large, modern and extremely innovative sailing cargo vessel. Some technical adjustments were required, which is expected for a new ship on the open sea.

Departure of Anemos for Santa Marta

Heading to Colombia and Back to France

Anemos' first commercial stop in New-York marks the first step of the journey. Docked for 2 days to unload the cargo, the sailing cargo ship will then set sail for Santa Marta in Colombia, to load coffee from BELCO before returning to its home port in France.

With the commissioning of Anemos, TOWT is laying the foundations for a true revolution in the maritime sector and becoming a key player in the logistics scene. A fleet of 8 sailing cargo ships is under construction for 2028, propelling TOWT to the rank of global leader in sailing transport.
