TOWT in a nutshell

TOWT – sailing transport, is a new-generation shipowner committed to decarbonizing shipping since 2011.

After several years of research and development, the first fleet powered by main propulsion is about to see the light of day, with a carrying capacity of around 1,100 tonnes per yacht.

At the same time, TOWT has also developed the ANEMOS label, enabling consumers to easily identify goods transported by cargo ships.

A powerful argument to convince shippers to opt for wind power, and thus envisage a real energy transition to meet the climate challenge.
